

Urgent Consultation Clinic

The Urgent Consultation Clinic (UCC) provides patients with a single consultation session with a psychiatrist for the purpose of medications evaluation, diagnostic clarification or follow up recommendations. Consultation is available for the following patient populations:

- Adults 18-65 years of age
- Perinatal and Postnatal

To be eligible for this service:

- You must have a family physician and a valid Alberta Healthcare number.
- Consultation findings are for clinical use of the family physician and are not released to third parties for forensic, legal, insurance or WCB purposes.
- Addiction is not the primary concern

The consultation appointment:

Before the consultation...
You will be contacted within 72 hours by
the UCC to book an appointment. You will
be given a reminder call 24 hours in
advance of your appointment. If you do not
attend this appointment, your referral will
be closed.

What to bring to the consultation...
Please bring all medications that you are currently taking in the original containers. If you no longer have the containers, you can bring a list of the medications. If you have questions, we recommend you write them down and bring them to the consultation.

During the consultation...
The consultation is a 45-60 minute interview with a psychiatrist. There may be medical students conducting the interview under the supervision of a psychiatrist.

After the consultation...
A brief report of the consultation will be sent to your family physician, which will include any treatment recommendations that were discussed with you. Please make a follow-up appointment with your family physician after the consultation.

The psychiatrist may provide medication recommendations to your family physician. It is the responsibility of your family physician to prescribe.
